



# Etta Daniels

As founding member of The Friends of Greenwood Cemetery Association Etta has dedicated 26 years to the restoration, and preservation of Historic Greenwood Cemetery. In addition to cutting down acres she has digitized the records of more than 40,000 burials of St. Louisans so that the record of their lives will not be lost and their burial sites can be found as a labor of love.

In 2008 she felt that Harriet Scott, who was buried at Greenwood Cemetery should have a monument at the front of the cemetery. This led to also adding a pavilion to this prominent space. After much painstaking research, Harriet's actual burial site was located, and in 2023 Etta helped obtain a beautiful new marker there as well. The official unveiling was an historical event for St. Louis attended by descendants and the community.
