In 2014, Aeneas Williams was inducted into the Football Hall of Fame at Canton, Ohio.

Yet in 1992 while in Arizona, his career not only set. him up for football greatness, but he often held Bible studies and ministered to his teammates to encourage them in their career as well as in their faith. This connection between the rough and tough on the field and being the firm, sometimes gentle but always respected spiritual leader in the home was an aspiration for him.
